

Chargers - charging cables can be found in the baskets in the lounge. The sockets have USB ports. There is also a cable for the dining table lamp.



HEATING & COOLING

Heating

The property is centrally heated by a combi boiler system and radiators.

The thermostat can be found on the lounge wall. To adjust the temperature simply dial the button to the required temp and press to set.

You do not need to press the side buttons and the heating and water should both show the ON symbol.

Airconditioning

There is a wall mounted aircon unit in the lounge. During hot weather the white remote control will be on the coffee table.

If you use the aircon all **DOORS & WINDOWS must be CLOSED.**

The Mode should be left on AUTO (A) and the Up and Down buttons can be used to set the desired temperature.

Please do not use this unit for heating.

If using the aircon the central heating thermostat must be turned down to 5 degrees to avoid the two systems battling.

Heating Thermostat




Aircon Remote Control



Control panel layout



- A** Oven / grill function knob
- B** Main oven temperature control knob
- C** Oven /grill temperature indicator

4. Operating modes

Oven functions

All functions of the ovens and grill are listed in this section. Please note* depending on the model of your oven, the number and order of operating modes available may deviate from the illustrations shown below.

Symbol	Function	Description
	Lamp	Turns on the oven light. This will automatically activate the cooling fan.
	Circular Heating Element and Fan	Air that has heated is blown by the fan onto the different levels. It is ideal for cooking different types of food at the same time (e.g. meat and fish) without mixing tastes and smell. It cooks very gently and is ideal for sponge cakes, pastries, etc.
	Grill and Fan	The top heating element is used in conjunction with the fan which circulates the hot air around the oven. Pre-heating is recommended for red meats, but is not necessary for white meats. Grilling is ideal for cooking thicker food items such as pork or poultry. Food to be grilled should be placed directly at the centre of the middle shelf. By sliding the drip tray underneath the shelf it will ensure that any are collected. For results always make sure that the food is not too close to the grill element and turn the food over half way through the cooking time.
	Defrosting	When the dial is set to this position, the fan circulates air at room temperature around the frozen foods so that it defrosts in a few minutes without the protein content of the food being changed or altered.
	Grill	Using the top heating element. Success is guaranteed for mixed grills, kebabs and gratin dishes. The grill should be pre-heated to a high temperature for 4 minutes. White meats should always be placed at some distance from the grill element, the cooking time is slightly longer, but the meat will be more succulent. Red meat and fish fillets can be placed directly onto the shelf with the drip tray placed beneath on the lower shelf position.

6. How to operate the main oven and grill

Setting the correct time



WARNING: The oven will not operate until clock is set.


When first switched on the clock display will flash '12.00'.

Touch the + or – buttons whilst the display is flashing to adjust the time. (The display stops flashing after 5 sec and time is displayed).

To adjust clock time:

Press mode button  x 4 times until clock symbol  is displayed. Touch the + or – buttons whilst display is flashing to set the time of day. (The display stops flashing after 5 sec and time is displayed).

Select temperature & Operating mode



- A** Oven / grill function knob
- B** Oven / grill thermostat knob

The operating modes of the electric oven are selected with the function knob. The temperature is adjusted with the thermostat knob.


How to use the Oven & Grill

1. Close the oven door
2. Set thermostat knob to the desired temperature
3. Set function knob to the required operating mode

The oven heats up to the adjusted temperature and maintains it. During heating, the temperature indicator light will remain on until the desired temperature is reached.

Shelf positions

The oven has 5 shelf positions as illustrated below, it is important to position the wire shelf into the runners correctly.



⚠ Please ensure shelves are fully inserted before closing the oven door, failure to do so could lead to damage to the door.

Warning - Do not place aluminium foil or baking trays on the bottom of oven cavity. This can lead to permanent damage to your appliance.

Warning - Do not place plates, dishes or trays on the bottom of oven cavity when oven is in use.

Warning - Do not use the oven or grill cavity for storage when not in use.

Switch off the electric oven

Turn function knob and thermostat knob to off position (top).

7. Clock Programmer

Minute Minder (0.01 min - 23.59hr)



Press mode button  x 1 time until alarm symbol  is displayed. Touch the + or - buttons to set the desired time duration. The alarm will sound when the selected time has elapsed. Touch any button to stop alarm.

To cancel:

Press mode button  x 1 time until alarm symbol  is flashing. Touch the + or - buttons to set the duration to 00.00.

Timer Cooking

Timed Operation Period

Oven cooks for a selected time period then stops: (0.01min to 23.59hr)



Press mode button  x 2 time until Cook symbol  is displayed and flashing.

Touch the + or - buttons to set the desired cooking time duration. (Display reverts to time of day after desired time period is set and  + **A** symbol remains lit).

Select desired oven cooking mode and temperature using the oven control knobs.

The alarm will sound and the Cook symbol  will flash when the selected cooking time has elapsed.

Turn oven control knobs to 'Off' and touch any button to stop alarm and return over to 'Manual' use mode.

To check time left:

Press mode button  x 2

To Cancel:

Press mode button  x 1 time until Cook symbol  is displayed.

Touch the + or - buttons until alarm sounds and display shows 00.00. Clock time returns.

Note: Whilst cook symbol  is flashing, the oven cannot be used in 'Manual' mode.

Time Stop Point

Oven cooks until a designated time then stops: (up to 23.59hr)



Press mode button  x 3 times until symbol **A** is displayed and flashing.

Touch the + or - buttons to set the desired stop time. (Displayed reverts to time of day after desired stop time is set and **A** +  symbol remains lit).

Select desired oven cooking mode and temperature using the oven control knobs.

The alarm will sound and the  symbol will flash when the selected time has been reached.

Turn oven control knobs to 'Off' and touch any button to stop alarm and return to 'Manual' use mode. (Timer will sound for 2 mins then stop if no button is pressed).

To cancel:

Press mode button  x 3 times until **A** symbol is flashing.

Touch the + or - buttons until alarm sounds and time of day returns.

Delayed Start Cooking

The two timed cooking modes can be combined to create a delayed start cooking period.

Programme a Timed Operation Period (as described on p12).

Then

Programme a Time Stop Point (as described on p12).

Both symbols **A** and  will be displayed and the cooking process will start at a future point in time e.g.

If Time Stop Point is set to 16.00 and Timed Operation Period is set to 1.30 hrs - the oven will switch on at 14.30 and cook until 16.00.

To Check Settings:

Push mode button  x 2 to see  cooking period.

Push mode button  x 3 to see **A** cooking end time.

To cancel:


Press mode button  x 2 time until Cook symbol  is displayed.

Touch the + or - buttons until alarm sounds and display shows 00.00 Clock time returns.

8. Key Lock

How To Use

Child Lock function is activated by touching Set + for a minimum of 5 seconds. From this moment on all other functions are locked and the display will flash **STOP** and preset time intermittently.



To set Child Lock function:

Press set + for a minimum of 5 seconds.



Display will then flash **STOP**

How To Deactivate


Child Lock function is deactivated by touching touchpad. Set + again for a minimum of 5 seconds. From this moment on all functions are selectable again.

HOB INSTRUCTIONS

5. Using the hob

-  Do not use the ceramic hob if the glass surface is cracked, as electrical parts are directly beneath.
- Switch off the appliance at the supply to prevent an electric shock and contact your supplier.
-  The appliance is not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate control system.
-  The hob surface remains hot after use. **DO NOT TOUCH.**

Turning on the hob

Touch the  key on the control panel for 1 second. Cooking zone displays illuminate. The hob is ready use now. You can select different cooking zones within the following 10 seconds. Other controls are not allowed to function when the main key  is being operated.

 and all relevant decimal point will flash in all cooking zone displays.

If no operation is performed within 10 seconds, the hob will automatically return to stand-by mode.

If you press the main key  for longer than 2 seconds the hob will turn off and return to stand-by mode.

Selecting cooking zones:

1. Turn on the hob.
2. Touch one of the cooking zone selection controls to turn on the desired cooking zone. After selecting the cook zone of the hob  decimal point will flash on the relevant cooking zone display.

If no operation is performed within 10 seconds, the hob will automatically return to stand-by mode.

3. Touch  or  keys to set the temperature level to a value between **1** and **9** or between **9** and **1**.  and  keys are equipped with repeat function. If you touch any of these keys for a long time, temperature level will continuously increase or decrease at every 0.4 seconds. If you start with  key, **1** appears on the display. If you start with a  key, set value appears on display (e.g. half second **A** and half second **9**). This indicates that the booster is activated.

Booster

This function facilitates cooking. When the booster is activated, the cooking will operate at maximum power for a certain period of time. Booster time depends on the selected temperature level. This is indicated with an **A** and the set temperature value which flash alternately on cooking zone display (e.g. **A** half

second, half second **9**) once the booster time is over, power of the cooking zone will be reduced and the temperature value will be displayed continuously.

All cooking zones are equipped with the booster function.

Enabling the booster function:

1. Turn on the hob.
2. Select the desired cooking zone by touching the cooking zone selection keys.
3. Use the  key to set the cooking zone temperature value to **9**. Once the temperature setting is made, **9** and **A** will appear on the display alternately. This indicates that the temperature value is set to **9** and booster function is activated.
4. Then use  key within 10 seconds to select the temperature setting you want to be activated for the remainder of the cooking process after the booster time is over. Use  or  keys to set the cooking zone to a value between **1** or **9** (it is supposed that level **6** is selected for the example).
5. **A** and **6** appear alternately on the display during the booster function. (At the end of booster period **6** will be displayed continuously).

Turning off the booster function:

1. Touch  key until temperature level decreases to **0** to disable the booster function earlier.

- If **9** will be selected as temperature level that will be activated after booster period and no other lower level is selected, then flashing of the screen will cease in 10 seconds. Booster is now deactivated.

Turning off the hob

If you press the main key  for longer than 2 seconds, the hob will turn off and return to standby mode. If there is residual temperature that can be used after the hob is turned off, this will be indicated with a  symbol that appears on the relevant cooking zone display continuously.

Turning off cooking zones individually

A cooking zone can be turned off in two different ways:

- By touching the  and  keys simultaneously.** Select the desired cooking zone selection key . Decimal point appears on  cooking zone display. Touch  and  keys simultaneously to turn off the cooking zone.
- By decreasing the temperature level to 0 with the  key.** Furthermore, cooking zone can also be turned off by decreasing the temperature level to **0**.

Key lock

You can protect the hob against being operated unintentionally in order to prevent children from turning on the cooking zone. Key lock function contains a few complex steps to lock the touch control unit. Key lock can only be activated and deactivated in stand-by mode.

Locking the module

- Touch the main key  to turn on the hob.
- Touch  and  keys simultaneously for at least 2 seconds.
- Then touch  key once again. Key lock function is activated and appears on all cooking zones.

Disabling key lock


You can disable the key lock as you have activated it.

- Touch the main key  to turn on the hob.
- Touch  and  keys simultaneously for at least 2 seconds.
- Then touch  key once again. Key lock function is activated and  appears on all cooking zones as long as the key lock is active.  will disappear when the lock is deactivated successfully.






